

Farmington River Camping Trip

We must arrange campsites so that there is one camper and one tent (or two tents) on each site. Therefore, space is limited. Payment in full is necessary to hold your space.

Cost: \$100. per person

Includes: dinners on Friday and Saturday evenings, breakfasts Saturday and Sunday morning and make and take lunches on Saturday and Sunday.

Please bring: wading staff, bug repellent, night light, camp chair.
8' – 9' 4 or 5 weight rod, tippet down to 8x

Firewood for evening campfires must be prepared lumber OR purchased at campground. It is illegal to bring wood from another area

Flies: Blue wing olives #20-24, caddis (tan, black, green) #14-22, light cahills #12-14, sulphurs #16-20, white Wulffs #10-12, pheasant tail nymphs #12-18, stonefly nymphs, copper Johns, green partridge soft hackles, black ghosts, woolly buggers.

A Connecticut fishing license is required for this trip. All participants must be members in good standing of LIFR.
